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Course Description

This is a required course for 9th grade students. The course includes 21st Century concepts and skills in the areas of employability, financial literacy and high school orientation. Students will match their interest and aptitudes to career options with a focus on using employment information effectively, acquiring and improving employability skills that allow people to gain, remain and advance in the workplace as well as in society. Students will use technology to enhance their class projects. Students will be expected to demonstrate money management and make informed, responsible financial decisions. *ELP activities are also incorporated into this section of the course.*
